- Prepare accurate quantity and cost estimates, including materials, labor, equipment, and other resources required for the project.
- Assist in the tendering process by preparing tender documents, analyzing bids, and evaluating contractor proposals.
- Participate in negotiations with contractors and subcontractors to secure favorable terms and pricing.
- Develop and manage budgets, monitoring costs, expenses, and commitments. Identify
 cost-saving opportunities and implement cost control measures to ensure projects remain within
 budgetary constraints.
- Track the changes to the design and/or construction work and adjust budget projections in line with these.
- Conduct detailed quantity takeoffs and measurements from architectural, engineering drawings and on-site walkabouts to determine the quantities of materials and resources required for construction.
- Coordination with Subcontractors to define and agree quantities of executed works to be invoiced.

- At least 10 years of working experience as a Quantity surveyor in construction with at least 2 years' experience in railway project.
