KEY RESPONSIBILITIES:

The South Regional Management Team Senior Geotechnician's core responsibility is to assess the physical, mechanical and chemical properties of soil and rock to design and monitor construction of foundations, retaining structures and earthworks for the South Region based in lecava.

DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES:

- To participate in creating processes to improve the design process and implementation of innovative design methods, considering client requirements.
- To provide support in the execution of tasks: design studies, design checks, opinions, expert opinions, quantity studies (preliminaries), development of technical specifications.
- To organize and monitor all aspects of the construction geotechnical monitoring programs, to provide support for analysis and design, and implement continuous improvement measures.
- To undertake geotechnical assessments, complex analysis, design calculations and detailed designs with efficient use of specialized software.
- To provide technical advice within the scope of one's specialization, to assist in the optimization of projects.
- To perform identification of soil and qualification for reinforcement.
- To perform qualification of the material to be used for embankments.
- To participate in task forces set up to deal with specific technical issues.
- To look at the risk of geological hazards and make sure any factors affecting engineering works are identified and managed.
 To authorize study reports and geotechnical tests
 To perform qualification of excavation or quarry material and correct layering.
 To monitor conditions during and after construction to make sure structures are stable in the short and long term.
 To prepare contract documents for construction.
