 - Maintain accurate Records, Documentation and Reports, related to Utility installations, including as-built drawings, Statutory Undertakers Utility permits, Inspections and Tests reports, and Contractor documentation.
 - Control of the performance of the Utility Subcontractors works in accordance with the Contract deadlines, Designs, approved Budgets and other conditions.
 - Plan and supervise Subcontractor daily, weekly and monthly work. Organize meetings on Site to ensure daily work is done accordingly Schedule and to plan next daily construction work.
 - Plan and conduct acceptance of works by Statutory Undertakers and Engineer in consultation with the South Management team, GMT Utility Manager, Supervisors and Subcontractors.
 - Coordination of interdisciplinary works with Section Management Team discipline Managers. Prepare and present optimal solutions for all parties involved.
 - Ensure compliance of construction works with Latvian legislation and the company's internal quality system.
 - Implement Quality control measures and inspections. Ensure adherence to safety standards, environmental regulations, and Utility discipline Standards and codes.
