SITE QUALITY MANAGER

The Site Quality Manager is responsible for ensuring that construction activities are carried out in accordance with applicable quality requirements, approved project documentation, and contractual obligations, and supporting consistent quality performance across site operations.

- Maintain accurate quality records and support reporting of quality performance.
- Support coordination with the FIDIC Engineer and other stakeholders on quality-related matters.
